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Editorial

BIOETHICS AND THE PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

NEW CHALLENGES WE WILL TACKLE IN THE COMING MONTHS

Think about it: even politics (we still don't know if fully and sincerely convinced) increasingly speaks of the unavoidability of Bioethics in our time and in society in general. The repercussions of ethical-cultural reflection are also evident on the political debate.

Day after day, Bioethics is confirmed as a young and strongly developing discipline, capable to turn the spotlight on crucial aspects of human life: birth, death, health, pain, pleasure, sexuality, democracy and civil coexistence, the environment, climate change, and even migration processes. In recent years these themes have assumed ever greater importance in our societies. In times of technologically advanced scientific knowledge, it is central to ensure the quality of people's lives so that Bioethics suggests new enriching paths.

We have already seen and documented this process in Jerusalem during the last UNESCO Chair in Bioethics World Conference - the thirteenth - in Bioethics, Medical Ethics and Health Law; therefore in this issue of the June Newsletter we will illustrate the upcoming developments and those planned, starting from the second half of the current year.

We want to emphasize three topics that are all of great importance. The preparation of the following events requires a synergy of efforts and commitment at all levels.

This year on October 19, World Bioethics Day will celebrate article 12 of the Universal Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights, dedicated to respect cultural diversity and pluralism. It says: "The importance of cultural diversity and pluralism must be given proper emphasis. However, these considerations must not invoke the violation of respect for human dignity, human rights and fundamental freedoms, nor the principles established in this Declaration, as well as to limit its goals." The Units of UNESCO's Chair of Bioethics are developing a series of initiatives to reflect, acquire awareness, debate and involve an ever-increasing number of people, not only those specialized in this field, but also belonging to a wider audience.

The research of solutions can improve the quality of life of individuals and of communities regarding the current topic of tolerance and respect for cultural identities. Recognizing its originality means appreciating its creativity and inexhaustible richness. It implies that ideal and concrete resources may be shared in all areas of life.

In this issue we will provide a detailed overview of the various tentative programs that the Chair's Units intend to present for the World Bioethics Day Conferences and other initiatives, such as round tables, performances and competitions. They are intended, in some cases, to be activated on a single day; in other cases, they are expected to take place over a longer period of time.

Following the chronological order, we need to mention the Conference of Asia Pacific Division that will take place from the 8th to the 11th of November 2019 in India a Chennai.

Finally, we recall the 14th World Conference of the Chair that will take place in Porto, Portugal, from 11 to 14 May 2020: Prof. Amnon Carmi invites all members of the Chair to participate with the most profound motivation, as he writes in his message in this Newsletter.

A Network of Teachers for the Promotion of Bioethics in High Schools

On March 23, 2019, at the Guzzo classroom of the University of Turin, the 1st National Conference was held, dedicated to the formation of a network of high school teachers interested in developing bioethics teaching in the classroom. Professor Maurizio Mori, President of the Bioethics Council, after the greetings to the defendants, presented the objectives of the initiative: to coordinate the teachers who in schools dedicate attention to the proposed bioethics with a "lay" attitude.

Among the speakers at the Conference, Greetje van der Veer of Itinerari Laici, Pescara, reiterated the concept of secularism, emphasizing the difficulties in Abruzzo to enter schools.

The second speaker, Marinella Maucioni of the Walter Piludu Association, told of her positive experiences in Sardinia where she is often requested by students in schools.

Daniela Truffo, of Ce.Se.Di (Educational Services Center) of the Metropolitan City of Turin, recalled the twenty-year collaboration with the Council of Bioethics Onlus, and how the proposal of bioethics in the classroom had the merit of offering a moment of breaking the didactic routine and called for the establishment of the Network as a factor to consolidate the process.

Among the professors who took part in the debate, Silvia Uggetti, underlined the importance of an external teacher to solicit the discussion and proposed at the operational level the reflection on bioethical topics as an alternative to the Catholic religion.

The colleague Sergio Mazza of Alba-Bra highlighted the centrality of the concrete cases as a didactic means to solicit debate and reflection.

Elena Nave, who for years coordinated the project of the Onlus Bioethics Council, recalled how important the annual catalog prepared by Ce.Se.Di. which makes it possible to make the offer of bioethics topics known in schools, and proposes that something else be thought of in other geographical and cultural realities.

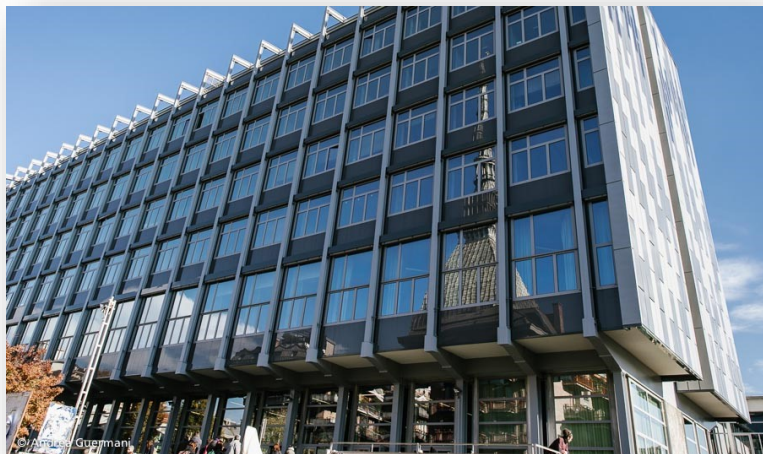
Matteo Cresti, qualified in moral and bioethical philosophy and committed as an "external expert" in many schools in the metropolitan city of Turin, drew attention to the interest in bioethics of young people of technical and professional institutes, which should be involved and not at all excluded.

As part of a first common reflection, the proposal to use the Sofia platform emerged, to propose a training course for teachers; the need for a deepening of what is meant by "secularism"; the opportunity to reconsider the teaching of the Catholic religion.

The Declaration of Intent for the foundation of the teachers' network for the promotion of bioethics in secondary schools informed by critical thinking, it was also signed by the delegates of the European Center for Bioethics and Quality of Life - Italian Unit of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Norma Trezzi and Luciana Paracchini.

On 12th of April 2019 the Conference organized by the Italian Institute for Bioethics of Italian Unit and dedicated to Italian high schools started at 5 p.m, after a visit to BIOGEM, the Research Centre located in the district of Camporeale, in Ariano Irpino, in the province of Avellino, Italy.

The subject was “Ethics and Experimentation “and the meeting took place in the Main Hall of the central building. Prof. Franco Manti, Professor of Philosophy at Genoa University, welcomed all those present and highlighted the importance of debate between students and experts, of pluralism of thought and the centrality of the students in this Conference.

Then Dr. Ortensio Zecchino, President of BIOGEM, spoke about the Institution, dedicated to biomedical research. Its aim is to carry out scientific research, disseminate its contents, promote cultural education and reflect on the dilemmas linked to the continuous technological innovations. Education is at the centre of BIOGEM ‘s teaching and scientific activity. For this reason, an Earth Sciences Museum is located inside the BIOGEM building, in order to think about and answer some crucial questions, such as Who are we and Where do we come from. It is not possible to speak about progress if a balance between scientific disciplines and humanities is not sought. We need to create a civic education about scientific research. In September a meeting titled “Homo sapiens and.... beyond” will take place in the BIOGEM headquarters

The debate will focus on humanities and scientific studies, on posthuman, mechatronics, robotics, apocalyptic and optimistic visions linked to scientific progress, on the protection of the acquired well - being and on the defense of human dignity. Dignity is carved into international papers, it is the needle of the balance in every sector of life, it refers to man as a whole and must be affirmed through a shared culture and legislators and judges’s interventions as well. After that, the high school students began their presentations.

1) ITIS S. Maria Capo a Vetere.

The history of medical experimentation was reconstructed starting from medieval Arabic medicine, passing through that carried out during the Second World War, up to the most recent ones witnessed in India, in Pakistan, in Italy itself and in many other countries. The Naples Charter, the Oviedo Convention and the Helsinki Declaration were mentioned, as they guarantee dignity and care for the person when new knowledge is produced, regulate in vitro experiments, both on humans and animals. These documents protect vulnerable people, guarantee the right to informed consent, the safeguard of the principles of justice and beneficence, the application of experimental protocols previewed and the evaluation of benefits. War prisoners, pregnant women, children, adolescents must not be subjected to experiments. Cash compensations, travels, technological devices are not allowed. The scientists involved in scientific research and experiments must take their responsibility: not by chance has an international moratorium been activated towards those who used CRISPR to inhibit the development of HIV in a couple of Chinese twins, thus producing cognitive modifications and other genomic alterations. Then the subject of the Placebo was debated. Its use is considered justifiable when cures do not exist. One must always operate according to the principle of informed consent and clinical effects must be measurable. The link between democratic principles and the right to care is a priority for research.

2) Suor Orsola da Benincasa High School, Naples.

The main subject was the meaning of Bioethics and biotechnology. According to the Greek philosopher Aristotle, the three different concepts of life were explained. The aims of biotechnology

were taken into consideration and thus the codes (1993, 2004, 2012) regulating this science as well.

The history of biotechnology was summarized: it is divided into a traditional one and an innovative one and it is linked to the most different sectors, such as those of agriculture and navigation. As far as this science is concerned, it is important to take into consideration the evaluation of negative results, the philosophical implications and the freedom of scientific research.

3) Gentileschi High School, Naples.

The topic was the birth and the development of Bioethics, starting from the Nuremberger Code, where the principles of autonomy, justice, beneficence and non-maleficence were established, as a consequence of the rejection of torture and the possibility to conduct scientific experiments on human beings considered unworthy of living. Then the Declaration of Paris (2005) and the a Protocol of Strasbourg were taken into account. It was highlighted how Bioethics is tightly connected to moral philosophy, which reflects on relationships and interventions among human beings.

No morality can be based on the principle of authority. After that, students focused on the issue of cloning, of which Dolly was the first case in the world. It was followed by the cloning of chickens, mice, cattle. The problem of the cloning of endangered species and of primates was raised, in the second case for the removal of organs. Therapeutic and reproductive cloning were explained. Issues linked to the use of organs and stem cells were debated. It was highlighted how human cloning is forbidden in Italy. Everyone thought about what the philosopher Jonas said: the clone is prevented from being a new person. Then Dr. Agnese Camilli, Coordinator of the Secretarial Office of the Bioethics National Committee in Italy, intervened and considered the level of the reports held till then excellent. She highlighted how Bioethics is involved not only in sciences, but in society and law as well. Jurisprudence often anticipates legislators, as many special cases arise, which are not covered by laws and need to be debated. In this regard, ethical committees are very useful, as they approach the local situations and lean on biolaw, which is aimed at studying the interactions between norm and praxis. In 1990, the Bioethics Committee of the Presidency of Ministers' Council was founded in Italy: it gives advice and answers questions formulated by Parliament, Ministers, citizens and Institutions. These opinions influence judgements and judicial proceedings. Dr. Camilli illustrated the organization of the Bioethics National Committee and demonstrated how nations, that intend to respect human rights, strictly tie Bioethics and Biopolitics.

THE ROUND TABLE OF EXPERTS

1) Prof. Buccelli, University Federico II, Naples He appreciated the commitment of the students and he noted the importance of the Charter of Naples which aims to protect the dignity and safety of people in case of experimentation. Man, as a person, is at the centre of the experimentation. Respect for mankind matters, not the interests of pharmaceutical companies. It was written in the newspapers that ethic committees often block research. Anyway, research that ignores dignity does not protect people, especially those affected by cancer or degenerative diseases and those who are in precarious or delicate conditions. It is always necessary to connect the abstractness of the reflections to the reality.

The conditions, risks, disadvantages and advantages of experimentation must always be explained to the patients; it is necessary to obtain an informed consent both in the case of profit studies and in the case of no-profit research. Neither an experimental drug nor a placebo can be administered indiscriminately: the patient must be placed in a condition of no - inferiority thanks

to information and informed consent.

2) Prof. Prodomo, University Federico II, Naples

He thinks that Bioethics must be taught in school through the Socratic method, that is through dialogue. BIOGEM is a symbol of change: now Biomedicine has replaced Physics as a guide in scientific studies, as it plays a fundamental role on an epistemological level. BIOGEM is creating bridges between humanities and scientific disciplines: the Cartesian analytical method and the Galilean system of reproducibility are actually anachronistic. History creates alternative worlds and now it is appropriate to translate knowledge into practice. Bioethics, by promoting the dialogue between different cultures, teaches tolerance, citizenship rights and the search for good and right.

3) Prof. Monica Toraldo di Francia, Stanford University in Florence.

She spoke about the Oviedo Convention, the Helsinki Declaration and the Bioethics National Committee. At the base of these documents there is a guaranteed rule, to which numerous exceptions are subtracted. In commenting on the presentations of the students, Prof. Toraldo di Francia recalled the international moratorium on embryos' trials. Nevertheless, some countries, such as China, don't respect these rules. Life is unavailable, regardless of the distinction between secular and religious ethics. Debating about limits is really important. When we talk about the principle of justice, we must not confuse it with equality. Instead, justice is very similar to equity. Often, the scarce resources of the health system creates a ranking of needs, also based on social issues.

On APRIL 13, Prof. Luisella Battaglia from the University of Genoa, member of the Bioethics National Committee, welcomed those present, recalling that from 2001 until today these conferences for high schools have been organized every year. Then, she announced that on the 29th and 30th of August 2019 Santa Margherita Ligure would host the Bioethics Festival.

1) De Sanctis High School, Naples

Students highlighted how scientists tried to change the characteristics of life through cloning and genome modifications. There was talk of Dolly the sheep, cloned and genetically modified primates, CRISPR/ CAS 9 methodology, and of eugenics and its positive and negative implications. Then the topic of assisted fertilization was introduced: the concept of sterility, fertilization, laboratory procedures, homologous and heterologous fertilization, ethical problems that can be posed for frozen embryos and rented uterus were explained and debated.

We asked ourselves what relationship must exist between the child and the biological parent in case of heterologous fertilization, if and when the embryo has the status of a person and whether perfect beings can be created.

2) Marconi High School, Pontedera.

Science, the protection of the individual, the value of scientific research were the subject of this intervention. The issues of compulsory vaccination and the use of cannabis in pain therapies were examined.

Some legislative gaps and the need for correct information on biomedical issues were highlighted.

3) Cicerone High School, Frascati.

Students take into consideration article 29 of Naples Charter, regarding the enhancements, its types and the age groups to which it is applied. In particular, the improvement and replacement goals of the enhancement were discussed; in addition, the ethical issues connected to it, the defense of casualty and the need for a technical control of genetic editing were debated as well. As the concepts of limit, equality and solidarity are in crisis, we need to think of an international framework for the regulation of genetic correction. It is desirable to promote a social conscience of scientific progress and the use of reasonable argumentation.

THE ROUND TABLE OF EXPERTS

1) Prof. Salvatore Amato, University of Catania, Member of the National Bioethics Committee. Prof. Amato said that cloning is like throwing the dice: one cannot imagine what health problems cloning involves. Therefore, we must take into consideration a series of issues connected to cloning: the limits of experimentation, the protection of people's rights, the dividing line between risks and benefits of the enhancement, the conditioning exercised by the market, the control tools and the rules that bind the experimentation.

2) Prof. Lorenzo Chieffi, "Luigi Vanvitelli" University of Campania.

The well-known jurists, expert in constitutional law, refers to article 32 of the Italian Constitutional Charter concerning health, freedom of care, wellbeing of the individual, respect for the person. Even though historical and cultural principles of the Italian people must be safeguarded, the importance of the evolutionary interpretations of our Constitutional Charter cannot be ignored, as the social reality changes constantly and new international documents are imposed, thus conditioning our regulations. It is important to adapt to new issues. The legislator is called to act with balance, discipline the regulations and provide guidelines that set a framework. Laws are required to be streamlined and large meshed, able to set limits, but leave the scientists with freedom and the responsibility to act. In Italy, ethical issues have been addressed late. Sometimes laws have been voted, but they are not applied. So confusion reigns.

3) Prof. Pasquale Giustiniani, Pontifical Faculty of Southern Italy University.

Bioethics, like Science, cannot be labeled with adjectives. The only one acceptable is "free". Its value consists in its problematic nature. It protects minorities, it deals with rare diseases, it thinks from the perspective of the last, it does not think in an anthropological, but in a bio systematic way. It is concerned about the environment and water resources. Even though research has to be funded, it can only be free.

THE HIGH SCHOOLS

1) High School from Lecce

A new exceptionalism is emerging: it compares the human being and the post humanone, more technologically advanced. Our body has always been considered a perfect machine. Can it be im-

proved? Certainly, through the duplication of chromosomes, telomerase, pluripotent stem cells, genetic manipulation. In today's technology society, science tends to be not limited; people are scared and technologically vulnerable. On the contrary, the bio-law takes into account the limits, protects human integrity, is not compatible with seriality and economic interests, does not objectify human body. The relationship between man and nature has changed. Now we are going to choose: will we face a natural or an artificial future? How is the environment changing? What is the use of a perfect body in an unhealthy environment?

Informed consent and care ethics. The Hippocratic paternalistic ethics, based on the fact that the doctor decided instead of the patient, was replaced by the request for the consent to the patient. The principles of autonomy, non-maleficence, honesty and truthfulness have been affirmed in the Helsinki Declaration. These principles can sometimes be in conflict with each other. In a care relationship based on respect and mutual trust, the doctor informs the patient and the patient, competent and active, consciously decides. Even though people's stories are different, everyone has the right to be informed, to be insured with a policy, too learn about accidents and problems that may occur. Taking care of oneself means taking care of the world and the others.

Respect for the human beings Respect is important both in treatment and in experimentation. For what concerns the genetic experimentation to which the twin Chinese sisters were subjected, prof. Nardini of S. Raffaele Hospital in Milan has invited his colleagues to evaluate cases like this with international involvement and to establish global observatories. In the Italian Constitutional Charter article 32 safeguards the respect for the person and guarantees the informed consent, which must meet the requirements of clarity and completeness. Article 35 regulates the doctors' ethics.

Since 1992 the CNBBSV has been established: it analyzes the results of biomedical research, acts as a guarantor and examines the questions related to gene therapies, in vitro tissues and nanotechnology.

The O.T.A. (Observatory of Advanced Therapies), which aims to eliminate preconceptions, to eliminate , to use a common language and to promote rapid access to advocacy has also been created.

In order to promote respect we will always have to ask ourselves about the meaning of dignity and person, from the beginning to the end of the life of a human being.

THE ROUND TABLE OF EXPERTS

1) Dr. Fallisico, BIOGEM Researcher and Neuroscience researcher in Sweden.

The post-human implies a new way of conceiving man, different from trans-human, a kind of hybrid. The use of smartphones changes the concept of man. Technology is natural for humans, so it cannot be stopped. Two important areas are Neurosciences and artificial intelligence (for example, a Google algorithm is a form of artificial intelligence). Many questions are unresolved: for example, do my ideals depend on my neuronal cells.

2) Prof. Toraldo di Francia

The trans-human refers to a current stage, to a transitional phase. This stage is optimistic: the brain is important, the body no longer. The post-human involves total pessimism because man is considered a network-person, always traceable and controllable. He is a man who has lost his freedom.

3) Dr. Camilli

CNBBSV is formed only by specialists in the sciences that debate issues related to GMOs, biogenetic and bio- economy . They often collaborate with the guarantor of privacy and with those who conduct investigations for forensic purposes.

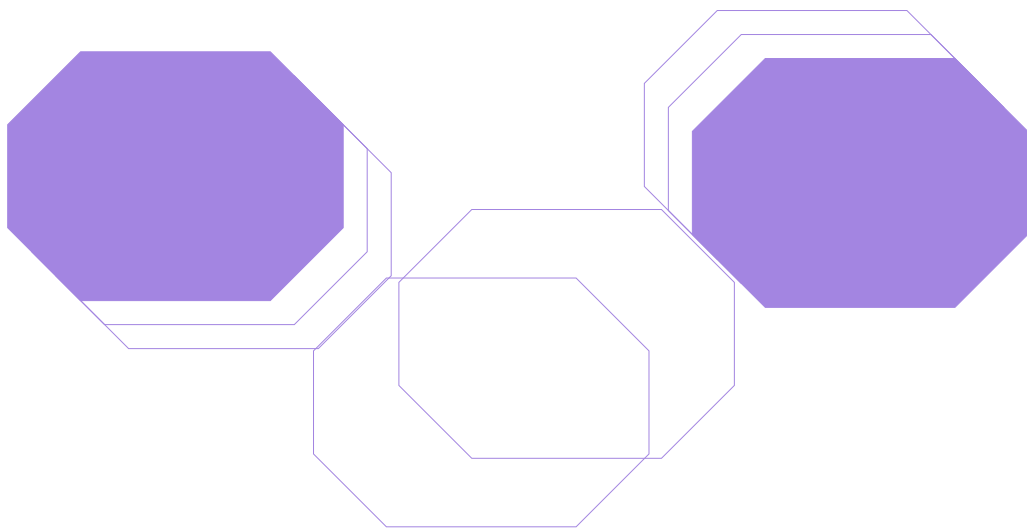
SHARING THE WEIGHT OF DISABILITY: THE FAMILY, A RESOURCE OR A LIMIT?

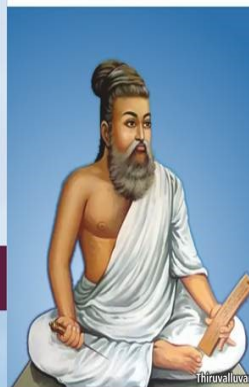

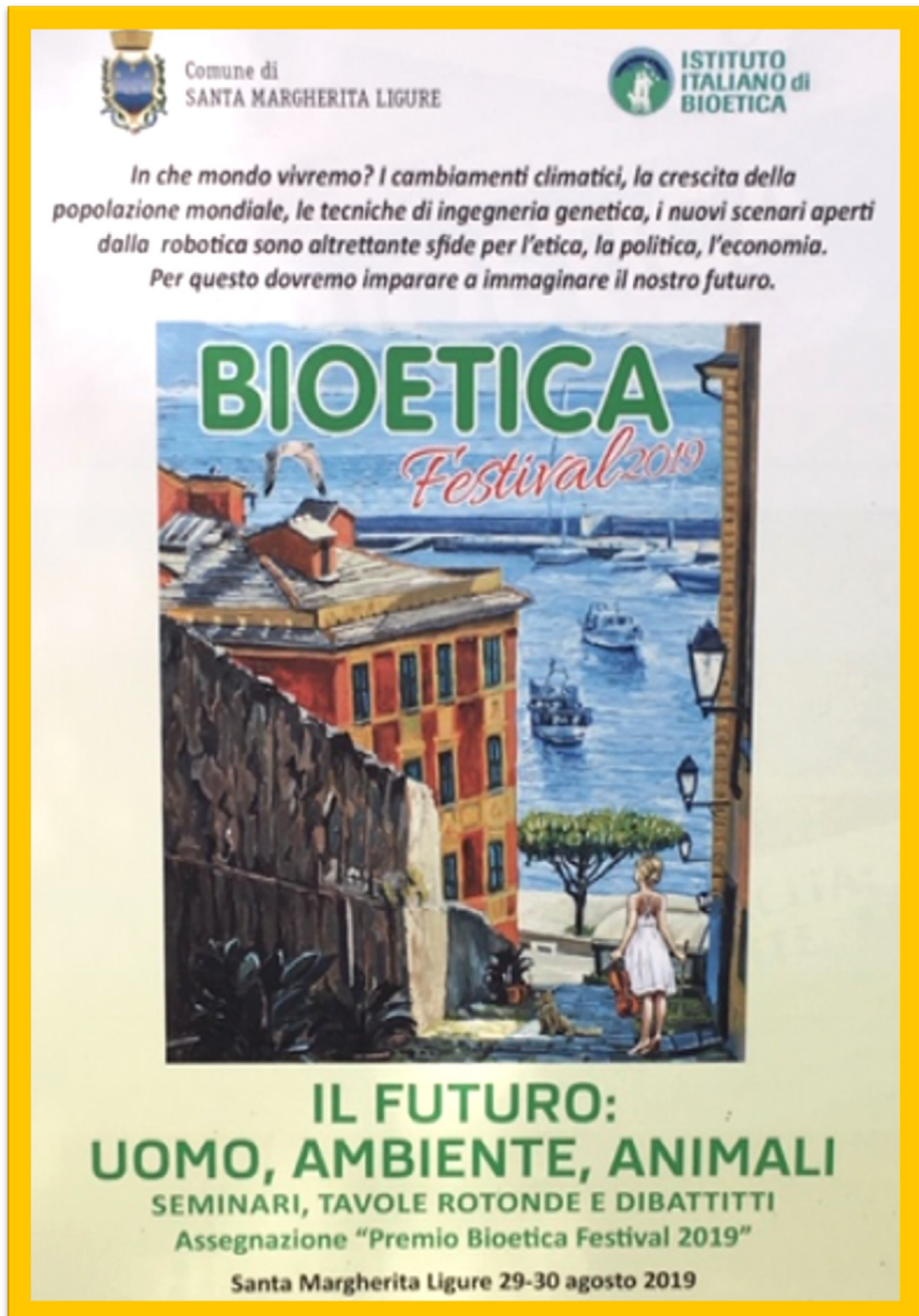

6. What were the positive sides talking about Bioethics and spreading bioethical message?

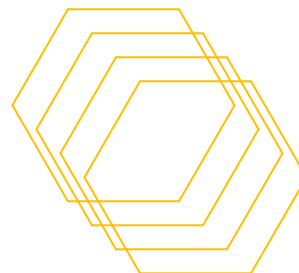
Help clarify there is a solid way to go and get knowledge and consciousness about life, people, me and the others. To protect life, to defend people, to clean up our world.

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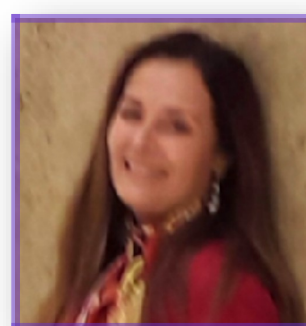
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
