Editorial

WHEN THE CORONA VIRUS EMERGENCY HAS PASSED, WE WILL BE IN THE HANDS OF SCIENCE AND UNDER THE PROTECTION OF BIOETHICS

Predictions are multiplying in these dramatic days, marked by the COVID 19 emergency: many forecasts, however, have been formulated to send a message of hope which all of us need.

As in a simulation, sometimes we imagine what we are not yet for now, as the children do: they play the role of nurses and doctors (this is a classic), merchants, lawyers, engineers, researchers (it is so fashionable, nowadays), daddies and moms or teachers (surprisingly re - evaluated with all school institutions).

In the same way, we may simulate how we will be and what would be better for us when the corona virus emergency has passed. We would like to think that the bioethical challenge will be relevant in the world, mainly due to its connection to medicine and public health issues. In the future, for sure, our personal commitment will be highly demanded in order to guarantee the freedom of scientific research in full respect for fundamental human rights and in order to safeguard each person and his/her dignity, in the next political and economic choices.

In the time we are writing, we do not know when the COVID 19 emergency will end and how many deaths and what destruction it will leave behind: in fact, both the virus and human behaviour- capable or incapable of fighting the pandemic- are unpredictable. Anyway, it is likely that deep consequences - on the emotional level - will stem from this global pathological experience.

We have to prepare on time and learn the lesson that doctors, researchers and nurses have taught us in their daily fighting against COVID 19 in this period. Each of them placed the value of human person at the centre of their actions, even when they put their lives at risk. Thanks everyone for the passion and competence shown on this occasion. Thanks for being able to re-launch the role of all health professionals.

We will be able to talk about this with justified pride and infinite gratitude at the next UNESCO Chair in Bioethics World Conference in Porto (March 8 — 11, 2021), forcibly postponed.

The simulation game we started from gives us some positive signs about our future. We are aware of the fact that it will be a different and sustainable future for everyone. We can get out of the tunnel which the pandemic forced us to enter, accelerating that transformation process

we have been working for such a long time. Our aim is to put the common good and ethics at the centre of human behaviour.

A renewed commitment to relaunch Bioethics in the world can ferry us out of the shallows in which we run aground, out of the contradictions of a selfish and unjust society that often sacrifices democracy and the environment to the logic of power and business.

These terrible days could give us a present: the understanding of what is necessary to do in the general interest and in a medium- long term perspective. Our pedagogical function too, that is teaching Bioethics, will find new opportunities. The whole world is proving more permeable than in the past to the promotion of a renewed awareness and an assumption of responsibility. Let's start from here.

Therefore, a period full of obstacles and unknown awaits us, but we can play the game with awareness and determination. None of us, however competent, will be left alone. We can help and unite each other, we must make our experiences in the world available to all of us. The Newsletter was also created for this aim and it goes on with these purposes of exchange of ideas and debate.

In this issue you will read articles about the activities carried out by the Units of the Chair in the last year, indications for the World Bioethics Day 2020, contributions concerning Bioethics and Disability, Youth Bioethical Education and so on...

Since many new Units entered the Chair, it is considered useful to inform them that they can collaborate both in the Newsletter and in the Global Bioethics Journal.

This issue will be concluded by the message of the Director of the Chair, Prof. Amnon Carmi.

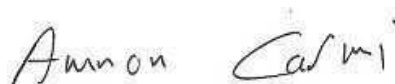

Part I:

Global Review

The establishment of the Chair

The Chair was established in 2001 and has been authorized to coordinate and stimulate medical ethics training among higher education institutes in developed and developing countries.

The International Network of Units

The various Divisions of the Chair were managed by Prof. Russell D'Souza (Asia Pacific), Prof. Vojin Rakic (Europe), Prof. Moty Benyakar (Latin America), Prof. Pierre Effa (Africa), Prof. Chongqi Wu (China) and Prof. Rui Nunes (Portuguese speaking countries) and Mrs. Shoshana Golinsky, the Administrative Manager of the international network.

In 2019, many new Units were established around the world. The International Network consists nowadays of 243 Units.

The Units' activities

More than 3000 activities have been done last year: 1361 Publications - including books (25), book files (20) book chapters (52) journal articles (1148), and multimedia materials (128), etc.

The World Conference on Bioethics, Medical Ethics and Health Law

The 14th World Conference on Bioethics, Medical Ethics and Medical Law was held in November, 2018. The 14th World Conference will be held in Porto, Portugal, May 11-14, 2020.

The International Forum of Teachers (IFT)

Many new members joined the International Forum of Teachers (IFT) that includes about 1030 members in more than 50 countries.
Prof. S. Popova of Bulgaria. Chairs the Forum.

The Chair's Newsletter and Journal

Dr. Vesinova (Italy) and her team continued to publish new issues of the Newsletter of the Chair. Her team published in 2019 an additional book and held seminars for the Department of Bioethics for Youth and Children. The first Italian book has been translated into English, French, Albanian, Bulgarian and Hebrew.

The Chair's Journal under the leadership of Prof. D'Souza published another two issues.

The World Bioethics Day (WBD)

The fourth celebration of the World Bioethics Day (WBD) has been held by lot of Units worldwide under the management of the international committee chaired by Prof. Pravin Arora (India).

The Research Department

The Department continued to run four researches under the guidance of its Head, Prof. Rui Nunes.

The Department of Bioethics in the Holocaust

The Department of Bioethics in the Holocaust was established in 2017 and continued with proactive activities under the leadership of Dr. T. Chelouche and Dr. S. Gallin.

The Indian Units

Last but not least, the largest number of national units were established in India by Professor Russell D. Souza

HIGH SCHOOLS NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON BIOETHICS 2020 (Italy)

Promoted by the Italian Institute for Bioethics, with the collaboration of the Non- Profit Bioethical Consult and CNR Committee on the Research Ethics and Bioethics, in agreement and with the patronage of the Bioethical National Committee, the Schools National Conference on Bioethics is expected to take place at the Studies University of Turin, at its branch office of Savigliano , on 17th and 18th April 2020.

High schools representatives from the Italian regions will participate in the Conference, after carrying out in-depth analyzes, organizing presentations and after making selections within the schools in order to allow the best groups to access this extraordinary cultural experience.

This year, the subject of reflection and debate is INFORMED CONSENT; the topic will be declined according to students' interests.

In fact, the theme is especially engaging; above all, it is fundamental for the formation of a civic conscience and the assumption of responsibility on the behalf of the students.

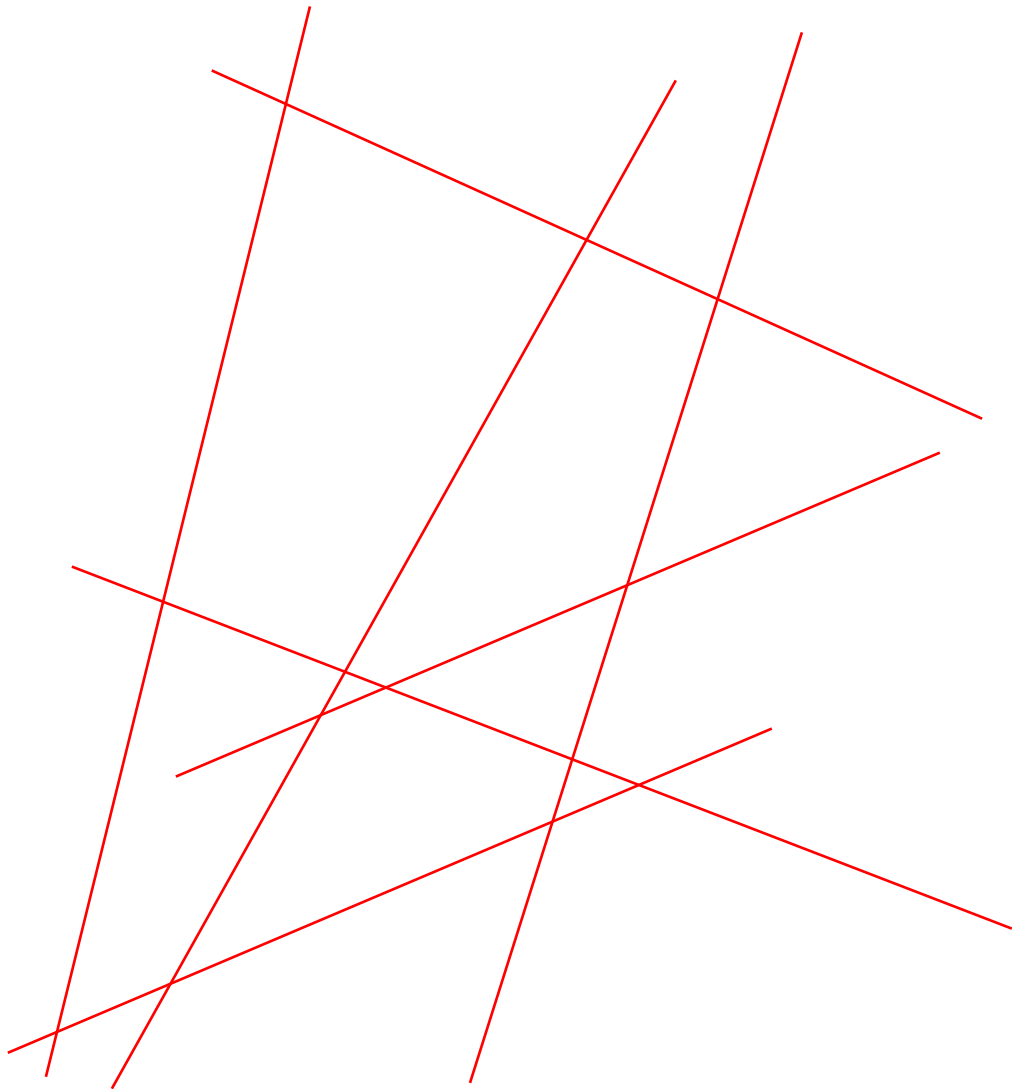
The topic is ideally framed in the doctor-patient relationship: in a shared decision-making process, in which patient's rights to information, care and self-determination are respected , in which his dignity and freedom are safeguarded, three important tools for their implementation are to be identified:

- 1) shared planning of the care: it is an ongoing process in which patients, helped by their doctors, take into consideration the possible evolution of their disease and express their opinion on the therapeutic treatments they would like to accept or refuse, if those circumstances came true;
- 2) the trustee: he is a person designated by the patient, who accompanies him during the time of illness, supports him in his decision-making process and is authorized to act as his legal representative when consensual decisions are needed on the treatment that the patient is no longer able to make;
- 3) advance decisions made by the patient: this document fosters respect for the patient as a person, affirming the right to equal treatment between those who are currently able to make decisions and those who are not.

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These points are only some reflections the students will develop in their research, recollecting some examples from the past and present.

Experts in Bioethics will be invited to hold speeches and students will be involved in very stimulating debates and confrontations of ideas.

BIOETHICS & DIS-ABILITIES (DIFFERENT- ABILITIES)

The International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health (ICF 2001) *“acknowledges that every human being can experience a decrement in health and thereby experience some disability. This is not something that happens to only a minority of humanity...”*

Over the years, the term disability has acquired different meanings often in contrast to that of handicap.

According to the International Classification of Impairments, Disabilities and Handicaps (ICIDH) of the World Health Organization (WHO 1980):

- Disability: In the context of health experience a disability is any restriction or lack (resulting from an impairment) of ability to perform an activity in the manner or within the range considered normal for a human being.
- Handicap: In the context of health experience a handicap is a disadvantage for a given individual, resulting from an impairment or a disability, that limits or prevents the fulfilment of a role that is normal (depending on age, sex, and social and cultural factors) for that individual.

This conceptual “revolution” focuses on disability not, like in the past, as a lack of health at different degrees, but as a source of the person’s remaining capacities regarded in a functional way; this radical shift considers handicap as the disadvantage coming even from the environment and the social context where a person lives.

In the subsequent “International Classification of Impairments, Personal Activities (ex-

Disability) and Social Participation (ex handicap or existential disadvantage)" (ICIDH-2) of 1999, WHO modifies the aforementioned concepts by expanding and enriching them with the following contents:

- replacing the term "disability" with personal activities, we consider the limitations of nature, duration and quality that a person undergoes in his activities, at any level of complexity, due to a structural or functional impairment. Based on this definition, each person can be disabled.
- abolishing the term "handicap" with social participation we consider the restrictions of nature, duration and quality that a person suffers in all areas or aspects of his life (spheres) due to the interaction between impairments, activities and contextual factors.

This entails that a person with a disability is not necessarily handicapped if, despite his/her limitations, can have the fulfilment of a respectable possible life, without any kind of physical and mental barriers.

"Disability is a complex phenomena that is both a problem at the level of a person's body, and a complex and primarily social phenomena. Disability is always an interaction between features of the person and features of the overall context in which the person lives..."¹

"The objective assessment of the degree of a disability in a sense of its social consequences (handicap) cannot rely solely upon medical criteria, but must take into account the vocational, social and personal contexts-especially the attitude of the non-disabled population..."¹

Enlightened by these concepts, we would like to introduce the "Bioethics & Dis-abilities (Different- Abilities) Project" that will start realising a booklet based on the UNESCO Cases' methodology. Its aim will be dual: promoting some of the principles set out in the 2005 UNESCO Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights, and sharing life experiences to overcome difficulties and limits.

Given that everyone can undergo unexpected events that can change his/her own life completely, and that there are many ways to react to them, we would like to focus ourselves on real cases where difficulties have turned into opportunities. Resilience as *"the ability to be happy, successful, etc. again after something difficult or bad has happened"*² and the capability to develop different abilities to behave against obstacles and troubles will be the key word of this work.

Moreover, it will be the right occasion to share the different expertise of the multiple professionals of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics Units all over the world. For instance, how to cope with survivors of mass disasters and a testimony of their new life recreated after their loss is an expertise of South - American Units. Speech therapists belonging to the Italian and other European Units will describe the impact of their work on immigrant patients to help their integration process in a new country or the chance for other patients to learn new ways to communicate improving their quality of life. Sport experts and professionals of other Units will contribute proving the importance of enhancing health and social skills practicing different sport disciplines, and so on.

Any kind of human impairment or discomfort as an occasion of creating new abilities not simply to survive but to improve the start of a new life represents more than a semantic revolution replacing the concepts of handicap and disability.

The cultural heritage concerning these topics still constitutes a blank wall in people's mind with its foreseeable consequences in daily life. Our aim is to sensitise and bring the reader closer to

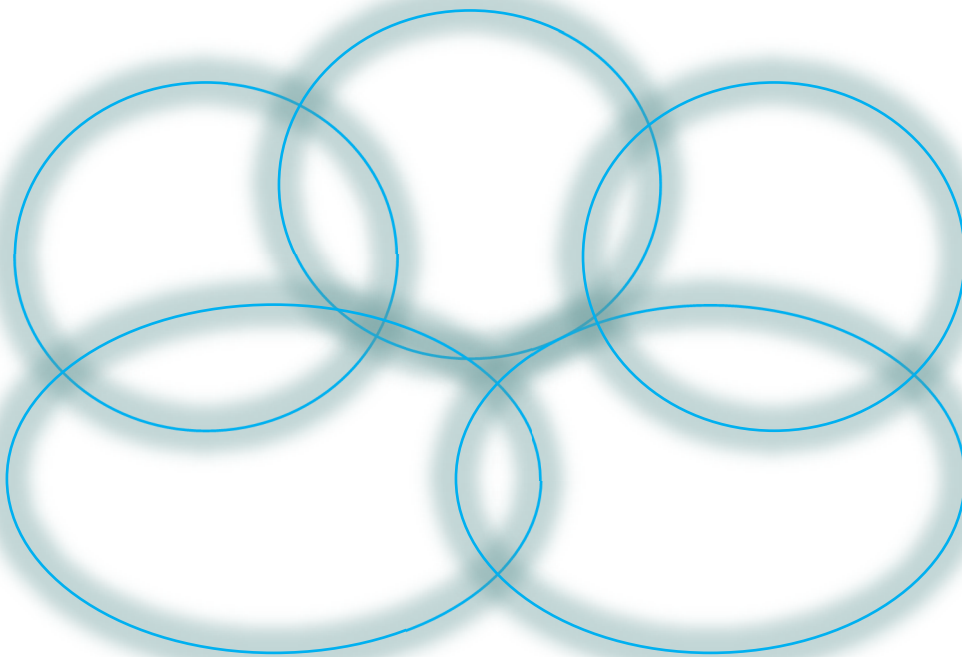
a world that seems too far and strange but in reality is not, offering a new point of view, hope and opportunities.

Each human being deserves a dignified life and is entitled to be an integral part of the society. *“The treatment given to disabled persons defines the innermost characteristics of a society and highlights the cultural values that sustain it ...Persons with disabilities are human beings – as human as, and usually even more human than, the rest. The daily effort to overcome impediments and discriminatory treatment they regularly receive usually provides them with special personality features, the most obvious and common are integrity, perseverance, and a deep spirit of comprehension in the face of a lack of understanding and intolerance. However, this last feature should not lead us to overlook the fact that as subjects of law they enjoy all the legal attributes inherent in human beings and hold specific rights in addition. In a word, persons with disabilities, as persons like ourselves, have the right to live with us and as we do”.*³

WORLD BIOETHICS DAY 2020

Honored Members of International Network of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Haifa,

International Committee for World Bioethics Day, UNESCO Chair in Bioethics (Haifa) announces the celebration of fifth **WORLD BIOETHICS DAY 2020** globally on **Monday, 19th October 2020**. All the Units of the Chair across the world (246 as of today) are expected to celebrate the **“Common Program”** suggested by Chair and WBD Committee, as part of their commitment to propagate Chair’s agenda. The theme for this year’s celebration shall be **‘Benefit and Harm’** (Article 4 of *Universal Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights*). The Common Program and Timeline of the events for **World Bioethics Day 2020** are suggested as below:

International Program: (To be coordinated by Unit Heads)

1. Name of Event: World Bioethics Day 2020.

- Official WBD logo** (on the top left of this page and also sent along with this email): It should be used for all the documents, programs, banners/flyers related to WBD.
- Official logo of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Haifa** (on the top right of this page and also sent along with this email): It should also appear on all the documents, programs, banners/flyers related to WBD.
- Official WBD International Banner** is prepared by WBD Committee and circulated to all Units along with the email containing this program.
- Official WBD Banner of Units**: Every Unit should prepare its own official WBD banner as soon as possible. The same should bear the official logos, as mentioned above under point no. 1(a) and (b).

2. First announcement: Units should announce the celebration of World Bioethics Day 2020 by the **end of March 2020** through their Universities/Institutions and institutional website(s) and/or other methods to all stakeholders (Teaching faculty/students/nurses/private practitioners/general public etc.). The International collaborators of Chair, e.g. WMA, IFMSA etc. shall also announce the program to their associates through their website(s) or by any other means as deemed fit and decided by them.

3. Submission of Draft/Tentative Program by the Units: 30th May 2020. The Unit Heads/Secretaries are advised to submit the tentative program of the celebration at their Units, latest by **30th May 2020**. This is only tentative program and Units can make changes in the same at a later date and before submission of “Final Program”. The purpose of this program is to express willingness to celebrate WBD 2020 by the Unit.

4. IMPORTANT: Promotion of Program by Units: It is advised that Units shall try to expand the program **beyond the limits of their Institutions to city, regional and national levels** and ensure involvement of other stakeholders. It may be either in the form of celebration beyond the physical boundaries of Institution and/or actively involving various relevant professional organizations of the city in which unit operates, such as doctors, nurses, physiotherapists, lawyers, judges, hospitals (municipal/corporate), philosophers, speech therapists, psychologists, social workers, journalists etc. Different

groups of citizens should be invited to take active part in various programs organized by the Units, such as seminars, posters, debates, panel discussions, films etc. Units may undergo Memorandum of Understanding, if required, with such professional organizations for the celebration of World Bioethics Day. Once such collaboration is established, Units should also announce, disseminate and promote WBD through channels of such professional organizations.

5. Submission of entries for various International Competitions: From the date of first announcement till on or before 10th August (Monday) 2020.

All the international competitions will be on the theme of the year i.e. 'Benefit and Harm'. This year the categories of International Competitions for students will be:

- i. Artistic Poster Competition
- ii. Scientific Poster Competition
- iii. Short films/ videos Competition
- iv. Photography Competition

Only **ONE ENTRY PER UNIT per competitive category** shall be allowed. All the entries shall be awarded Certificate with the name of Student(s) and Unit. **ONLY STUDENTS** are allowed to participate in these International Competitions. NO FACULTY/ STAFF entries will be entertained. All entries should be sent along with the details of the participants' viz. Name, Course, Year/Semester of Study, Name of the Institution, Name of Unit and Unit Head. The document containing such details (or details as will be prescribed later in the Rules for International Competitions) should be signed by the student and Unit Head.

All Units can participate in International Competitions. If a Unit has multiple sub-units, such sub-units are NOT permitted to send separate entries. All such sub-units may send their entries to their Unit, which in turn shall select **ONLY ONE** entry per competitive event and submit the same as Unit's entry in that event category. The winners will be awarded.

It is suggested that Units should hold such competitions at their local level before **Friday, 31st July 2020** and the First Winning entry should be sent for International Competitions before **Monday, 10th August 2020**. All such entries of local competitive events along with winning entries may be displayed for the audience during the WBD celebrations on 19th October 2020.

Note: Please submit the entries under above competitive category heads only. Entries submitted under changed category heads/titles will be rejected.

6. Progress Information:

- a. Unit Heads should keep their **Regional Coordinators** (as per the list mentioned below with email ids) informed about the developments and any hindrances/difficulties faced by them.
- b. **Regional Coordinators** shall share the information about developments in their region and any issues faced by them/raised by Units with Head of WBD Committee, so that necessary and timely measures can be taken to resolve the same.

7. Submission of Final Program by the Units: Before 15th July 2020 to WBD Committee at worldbioethicsday2020@gmail.com and to Newsletter Editorial Board at bioethicalvoicesnews@gmail.com

8. The Report of WBD 2020 celebration: Units will need to submit a report on **World Bioethics Day 2020** as celebrated by their Units on or before **10th November 2020** to WBD committee and to Newsletter Editorial Board at bioethicalvoicesnews@gmail.com

9. Special WBD issues of the Bioethical Voices Newsletter: July 2020 (Will publish Final Programs of Units) and December 2020 (Will contain WBD 2020 reports of Units).

Common Program for Units (to be celebrated on 19th October 2020):

Session I: (Pre-lunch Session: 10:00 am onwards till lunch)

Part 1.

- Opening speech by Head of the Unit or Head of the Institution.
- Speech(es) by Head(s)/ representative(s) of collaborating Professional Organization(s).
- The greetings of International or local representatives of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics.
- The presentation of an award to an active member of the Unit.

Part 2. Guest lecture/Panel Discussion/Symposium on “Benefit and Harm”, by experts in Bioethics/Senior Faculty and also involving student representative(s). Targeted audience should be junior staff, PG residents, UG students and Paramedics (Nursing and other supporting staff) and other stakeholders as decided by the Unit.

Session II (Student Activities): To encourage and enhance students' participation in the program, the activities in the **Post-Lunch Session** should include:

Part 3. Scientific Paper/Poster Presentation/Student Debate on Benefit and Harm (WBD Committee is pleased to share that Hon'ble Chair and Prof. Russell D'Souza (Editor-in-Chief 'Global Bioethics Enquiry' – Chair's Journal) have agreed to consider **Winning Papers** in such local events for publication in 'Global Bioethics Enquiry').

Part 4. Drawing/ Rangoli/ Poetry Competition: (The Theme for competition shall be “The WBD Theme of the Year” i.e. Benefit and Harm)

Part 5. Display of entries of Scientific/Artistic Poster Competition, Short film/video Competition and Photography Competition (The Theme for competition shall be “The WBD Theme of the Year” i.e. Benefit and Harm).

Part 6. Valedictory Function

In addition to above, all Units should prepare flyer or poster for **World Bioethics Day** event. It is further suggested that these flyers/posters may be prepared by the students of various Institutions/Units and should be based on the **theme of the year**.

(PS: Units are permitted to make appropriate changes in the common program to suit their requirements. Units are entitled to plan their celebration on a different date in the month of **October ONLY** subject to local considerations.)

In addition to International Competitive Events and Local Events, other Unit level events suggested are:

- I. Essay writing competition.
- II. Skit/Play/Drama/Music
- III. Symposia.
- IV. **Bioethics fair.** Students may put up stalls and have street plays to create awareness among their colleagues, practicing doctors and laymen.
- V. Media appearances (Television/Radio).
- VI. Newspaper articles.

Units can choose any of the above or plan any other additional activities, depending on feasibility.

Program for Students' Wings of the Units:

Students' Wings of the Units should be actively involved in the celebration of the event. Unit Heads, Steering committees of the Units and of Students' Wings should ensure maximum participation of the students in the event. Students should pro-actively participate and play important role in conduction of most of the ceremonies.

Students can also be involved in some social activities, depending on the feasibility of individual Unit and Institution. These can be:

- a. Awareness programs at community level in the form of talks, role plays, skits etc. based on the theme of the World Bioethics Day 2020.
- b. Distribution of clothes, food etc. to needy.
- c. Any other.

Common Program for Students' Associations:

IFMSA along with its associate medical associations Worldwide will actively participate in the celebration of World Bioethics Day 2020. IFMSA is preparing their WBD plan and will soon release the same for their member associations. IFMSA should release the tentative/confirmed dates for various planning milestones for their member associations, as deemed fit to them.

Important Notes (For all):

1. It is suggested to include as many stakeholders as possible in the celebration of the program.
2. Units have the liberty for minor modifications/additions/deletions to the program.
3. All Units can participate in International Competitions.
4. All correspondence related to World Bioethics Day 2020 should be ONLY on: worldbioethicsday2020@gmail.com
5. **Having week long celebrations:** Units, if want, may hold week long program as per their feasibility (though it is not suggested as common program for all the Units), but this celebration should not change the Common Program as suggested for the **World Bioethics Day 2020**.

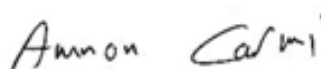

RULES FOR ENTRIES TO BE SUBMITTED FOR WORLD BIOETHICS DAY 2020

INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

General Rules:

1. ONLY STUDENTS of Units/Sub-Units/Institutions/Organizations of and schools/associations collaborating with International Network of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Haifa can participate in the International Competitions (herein after referred as 'Competitions'/'Competition') announced and organized by World Bioethics Day Committee (herein after referred as 'WBD Committee'/'Committee') on occasion of World Bioethics Day 2020.
2. The theme for competitions in all categories shall be the 'Theme of World Bioethics Day 2020' i.e. **'Benefit and Harm'**.
3. All the entries viz. artistic poster, scientific poster, short film/video and photograph should be submitted in digital format only, as mentioned below under specific guidelines for that competition.
4. Only ONE ENTRY PER COMPETITIVE CATEGORY PER UNIT can be submitted. In case more than one entry is submitted by a Unit, ONLY ONE of the submitted entries shall be considered for the competition. The decision of the Committee in this regard, shall be final and binding. No request to change the entry shall be entertained.
5. Please mention clearly the name of the category under which the entry is being submitted. The name of the category should be mentioned as mentioned in this document. Use of alternative names for any category is not permitted. In case of unclear or misleading communication the decision of the Committee, regarding including the entry in a particular category or excluding the entry from the competition, shall be final and binding.
6. Students may participate as individuals or in teams. If there will be more than one participant for one entry, only ONE prize shall be awarded, but individual certificate of participation as a team shall be given to each participant.
7. There is NO provision of any kind of (cash or otherwise) reward to the winning individual/team.
8. All the submitted work scientific/artistic posters, photographs, short films/videos should be the original work of the participant(s).
9. The submitted entry/entries should NOT have been presented at any other competition previously or concurrently or made available at any public domain (including electronic and non-electronic media) or used for commercial purposes, except at the Unit/Institute/Organization member of International Network of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Haifa during WBD 2020 celebrations.
10. All the entries must be prepared/shot ONLY AFTER 1st March 2020.
11. Each entry should be submitted with a document mentioning participant's name, complete postal address, telephone/mobile number, e-mail ID (if any), date of preparation/shooting of poster/ photograph/ film, name of Unit Head and the Unit to which participant belongs and should be signed by participant and Head of Unit.

12. **EACH ENTRY** should accompany an undertaking confirming that the participant is the rightful owner of the submitted work and that (s)he has obtained any necessary third-party releases and also mentioning the date of preparation of the entry. Participant shall also agree that the organizers will not be responsible for any claims/suit challenging the authorship, or infringement on the privacy of any person clearly recognizable in the submitted entry.
13. Participant shall grant to the WBD Committee, without need for attribution, prior permission or additional pay or consideration: the right to use the submitted entry royalty-free, world-wide and in perpetuity; the non-exclusive license to copy, display, distribute, reproduce, and create derivative works of the submitted work, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or subsequently developed for all UNESCO Chair in Bioethics (University of Haifa), WBD Committee and their authorized subsidiary bodies' non-profit public information and benefit purposes.
14. The entries submitted for competition shall become the property of World Bioethics Day Committee of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Haifa, though the copyright shall remain with the participant.
15. Any entry, during or after the competition, even if awarded the prize, but later found to be against the rules set for this competition, will be disqualified for the contest and the prize shall be cancelled and forfeited.
16. **Last Date:** Entries in all categories should be submitted latest by 10th August 2020. Late entries shall not be entertained.
17. The entries should be routed through the email id of Head of the Unit **ONLY** to worldbioethicsday2020@gmail.com only. Committee shall not be responsible for misrouted entries. You should receive automated acknowledgment email on successful delivery of your entry in the inbox of above mentioned email.

Poster Rules & Criteria:

Poster Specifications

1. Artistic posters can be handmade or digitally created.
2. Scientific posters should be created in digital format only.
3. All the posters (scientific/ artistic) should be submitted in electronic format (PPT or jpeg/jpg) only.
4. Handmade artistic posters should be photographed in adequate and proper light and be submitted in jpeg/jpg format only.
5. Presentation
 - a. Horizontal or vertical.
 - b. Border or non-bordered.
 - c. Written legends, slogans, or phrases may or may not be used. Color or Black and White.
 - d. Any number of colors can be used on the poster.
 - e. All mediums can be used (markers, crayons, pastels, paint, print etc.).
 - f. Original photography, magazine clippings, stencils, buttons; glue-ons may be utilized on the poster.
 - g. Poster Text: There are no specifications for text/font size. Text should be of sufficient size for easy reading at a distance.

Judging Criteria:

- a. **Coverage of Topic-** Details on the poster captures the important information about the WBD theme 'Benefit and Harm'.
- b. **Organization/ Logical Sequencing of Ideas-** Organization of information with clear titles and subheadings. All graphics are related to the topic and make it easier to understand.
- c. **Layout & Design-** All information on the poster is in focus and can be easily viewed and identified from a distance.
- d. **Mechanics-** No grammatical, spelling or punctuation errors.

Decisions by the judges and WBD Committee shall be final and binding. Entrant agrees to comply with and be bound by the decisions of the secretariat and/or of the panel of judges on all matters associated with the contest and waives all rights to judicial recourse in case of disputes.

PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS AND COMPETITION RULES

1. Each student may submit one good quality, digital image (jpeg/jpg format not less than 300 ~~dp~~dp).
2. By submitting the photograph for consideration, the photographer attests that:
 - a. Entry is an original photograph.
 - b. S/he created the image and owns full copyright to pictures submitted.
 - c. Entrant is prepared to certify this attestation on request.
 - d. Submitted image has not been published anywhere else or won prizes in any competitions or has been used for commercial purposes. Any such images are not eligible for the competition.
 - e. Submitted image has not been submitted in any other photo contest.
 - f. S/he has obtained all necessary third-party releases.
 - g. If deemed necessary, the student may also be requested to submit the original source files.

Technical Specifications

- a. HDR images and stitched panoramas are NOT eligible.
- b. Editing or otherwise digital manipulation that distorts the reality of the images will not be allowed. Only basic enhancements such as sharpening, contrast adjustment or simple cropping will be allowed.
- c. High resolution digital format are eligible
- d. File size should not be more than 10 MB.

Conditions of Contest

- a. The student should confirm that they have shot the photo, and are the rightful owner of the photo, and that have obtained any necessary third-party releases.
- b. WBD Committee reserves the right to disqualify photographers who: are unable to validate the information submitted; tamper with the process; or breach Contest Rules.

Judging Criteria

Photographs will be assessed for their:

- a. Creativity and originality
- b. Composition (Technical excellence and quality)
- c. Artistic merit (wow factor) and
- d. Content (Relevance)

Decisions by the judges and WBD Committee are final. Entrant agrees to comply with and be bound by the decisions of the judges on all matters associated with the contest, and waives all rights to judicial recourse in case of disputes.

SHORT FILM / VIDEO COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS AND COMPETITION RULES

This is a short film competition and hence ONLY Short Films should be submitted NO DOCUMENTARIES shall be eligible for the competition. The entries can be short digital animation films too on the topic.

Technical Specifications and Rules:

- The films shall not be more than 5 (Five) minutes (300 seconds), including the beginning and end credits. Films exceeding this time limit are liable to be rejected. The minimum length should be 30 seconds including credits.
- The short films should be in ENGLISH preferably, else ENGLISH SUBTITLES are must.

FORMAT:

The films may be shot in MPEG4 or AVI format. The recommended ratios are: 16:9 / 16:9 Full Height Anamorphic – in DV / HDV.

RIGHT TO SCREEN:

The World Bioethics Day Committee will have the exclusive rights to screen (non – commercial) the film on the respective websites or other associated screenings.

COPYRIGHT:

The Film must not contain any copyrighted work(s) belonging to third parties unless (1) Participants have a license to use such works in the Film; or (2) the use participants' Film makes of such works, is a fair one under the copyright laws. Participants will retain any licenses and provide them to organizers upon request.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Short Films / Videos will be assessed for their:

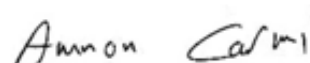

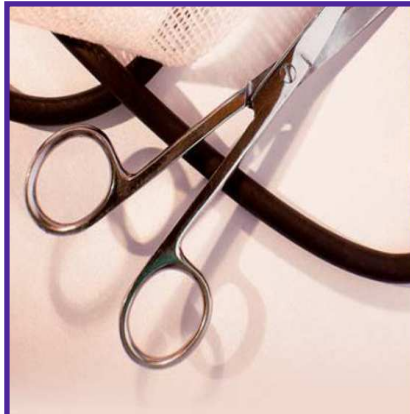

The conference will be held at the same venue, Porto Palacio Hotel, under the same conditions and according to the original scientific program.

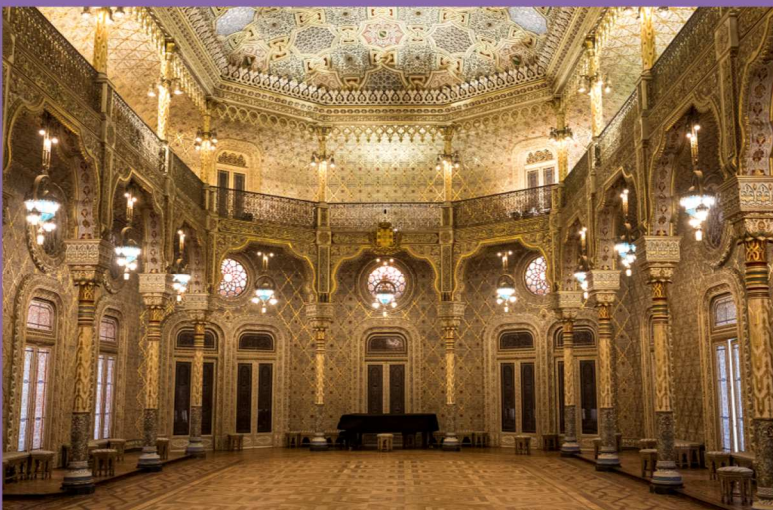

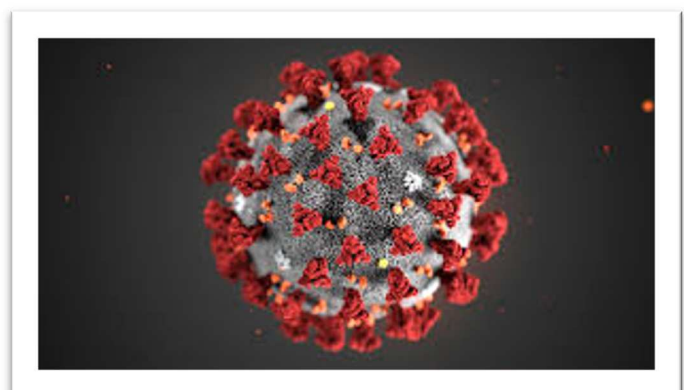
